## Agudath Israel Commends the Approval of the Anti-BDS Resolution in New York City

Agudath Israel commended New York City Councilmembers for voting to approve the anti-BDS resolution 40-4 with six abstentions. Prior to the council vote, Agudath Israel issued the statement below:

Agudath Israel of America urges New York City Councilmembers to cast their vote in favor of Resolution 1058-2016, the "Anti-BDS" resolution.

The BDS movement seeks to exclude Israel from the economic, cultural, and academic life of the rest of the world, and targets not only the Israeli government but Israeli academic, cultural, and civil society institutions, as well as individual Israeli citizens and, in some cases, even Jews of other nationalities who support Israel.

The BDS movement is widely, and not without reason, seen as a manifestation of animus against Jews as a people, and thus well deserves the opprobrium this resolution will communicate.

It is especially appropriate that the legislative leadership of New York City, which is home to the largest Jewish community outside of Israel, go on record condemning this misquided, dangerous movement to delegitimize Israel.
