My boss offered me some work, but less than my regular hours. The pay I will receive is more than my partial benefit rate, and I, therefore, will not be eligible for any Unemployment benefits (including the extra \$600/week). Must I accept the work I am offered, or can I continue receiving Unemployment?

I have a playgroup in my home. I heard that daycares are allowed to open on June 15th, but the restrictions are difficult for me to follow. I would prefer to remain on Unemployment rather than open my playgroup. Can I stay on Unemployment even though my daycare can officially open?

My children's daycare is not opening. I am the primary caregiver of my children. Can I remain on PUA, or do I need to find new childcare arrangements for them?
