New York State Loan Programs Now Open

Dear NYC Principals and Administrators,

The ordering period for the New State loan programs for the 2021-22 school year is now open.

The following chart shows the 2021-22 per-student allocation for all four NYS loan programs.

Program	Allocation Per Student
New York State Textbook Law (NYSTL)	\$58.25
New York State Software Law (NYSSL)	\$14.98
New York State Library (NYSLIB)	\$6.25
New York State Computer Hardware (NYSCH)	\$10.57

Schools who want to take part in early ordering can do so if they submitted the following:

- October BEDS data report for SY 2020-2021 to SED
- D O E Loan Request Enrollment Certificate for SY 2020-2021 to ONPSNYSTLLREC@schools.nyc.gov.

The preliminary NYSTL (Textbook) allocation levels are based on the 2021 BEDS data

with adjustments made later on in the fall, if applicable based on new enrollment figures for the new school year. In the fall, the 2021-2022 school year DOE Loan Request and Enrollment Certificate (LREC) form will be available for download on the DOE's Non Public-School [New York State Loan Programs Info Hub](#) site.
